They supplied the wrapping paper and ribbon and took special care of all of the gifts. Many gifts were completed within an hour!


"This was a wonderful help! They did such a great job," said Kristina, our Spanish Specialist.

Charlotte Price




Sally recently shared her singing talents. She had the opportunity to perform in the New Vision Dance Company Caberet Fundraiser shows.
